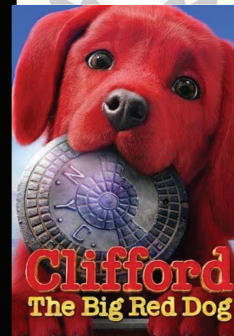

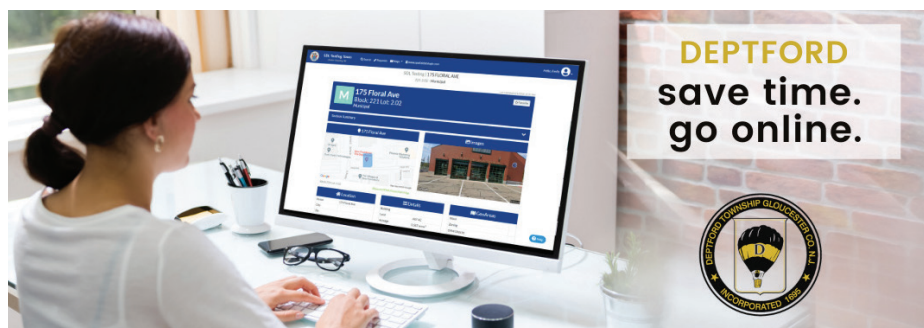

## DEPTFORD TOWNSHIP PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The Department of Public Works delivers a vast array of services to the residents of Deptford Township including road maintenance and repair, street sweeping, snow removal, fleet maintenance, leaf and brush collection, bulk appliance collection, installation and maintenance of street signs, storm water management and oversight of the Municipal contract for solid waste and recycling collection. In addition, the Parks Division of Public Works is responsible for upkeep, maintenance and improvements of all Deptford Township owned properties and public parks. The Public Works employees work very hard to provide a healthy, safe and attractive environment for the citizens and visitors of Deptford Township.

## WELCOME TO THE TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE

The Tax Collector's office is responsible for the billing and collection of all property taxes. Your tax bill includes the funds for the County, County Open Spaces, School District, Fire District, Municipal, and Municipal Open Space.

Tax bills are to be given to new owner upon the sale of the property. (NJ 54:4-64) Failure to receive a tax bill does not relieve the owner from paying property taxes and interest will be applied to all late payments. **Bills are mailed out annually in July.**

### AFTER HOUR PAYMENTS

After hour payments can be made by placing payment in the citizens drop box located outside main entrance. **Please do not leave cash payments in the mail box.** Reference your block and lot on your check to ensure proper processing.

### TAX PAYMENT DUE DATE AND INTEREST

Taxes are due and payable on the 1st day of February, May, August and November. Deptford Township allows a ten day grace period, if payments made after grace period, interest starts to accrue back to the 1st day of the due date month.

Interest on late payments is calculated at a rate of 8% for the first \$1500 delinquent and all amounts over are calculated at 18%. There is a 6% year end penalty if delinquent taxes are over \$10,000 as of December 31st of current year.

### TAX SALE

Tax sale is held once a year. If a property has prior year(s) delinquency in taxes, water, sewer or Property maintenance, the property will go to Tax Sale if not paid on or before the tax sale start time. Tax sale will be advertised in a local paper, four consecutive weeks before tax sale date and posted in five (5) places within the Township of Deptford.

### DEDUCTIONS ON PROPERTY TAX

A \$250 deduction is available on property taxes for any qualifying Senior, Disabled Person, Surviving Spouse of Senior or Disabled Person, Veteran and Widow of Veteran. Applications are available in the Tax Collectors Office or Gloucester County Tax Assessor's Office. SDL PORTAL

## NJ BAG BAN: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

### When does the bag ban go into effect?

New Jersey will ban the distribution of single-use plastic bags and certain types of takeout food containers starting on May 4, 2022.

### What will the bag ban include?

The ban will prohibit stores, including retail, from selling or providing single-use plastic bags for carry out purchases.

Non-grocery and retail stores — which the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection defines online — can still provide paper bags. Thus, clothing retailers and small shops are OK to hand over your purchase in a paper bag, or charge you for one.

However, large grocery stores — anything over 2,500 square feet — cannot give out or sell paper bags at the register. Most grocery stores are between 12,000 and 40,000 square feet, according to a trade publication.

New Jersey's ban doesn't cover single-use plastic bags that you can purchase. Garbage bags, pet waste bags, and Ziploc-style bags will still be all allowed in the state.



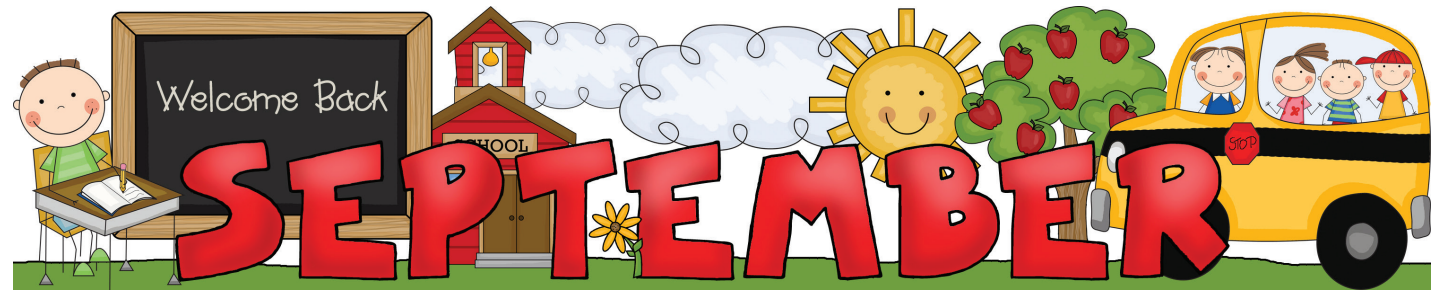

## Pre-K & Kindergarten Registration

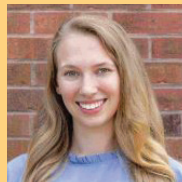
